IMPORTANT INFORMATION

TECHNICAL ENGINEERS' RETIREMENT SAVINGS FUND (401(k) PLAN) AND SAVINGS PLAN

TECHNICAL ENGINEERS' RETIREMENT SAVINGS FUND(401(k) PLAN):
 The employer shall deduct from the wages (before taxes) of each Technical Engineer and Instrument Man enrolled in the 401(k) Plan one dollar and fifty cents (\$1.50) per each hour worked for the Technical Engineers' Retirement Savings Fund (401(k) Plan). The employer shall deduct from the wages (before taxes) of each Rodman, Fourth and Fifth Year Apprentices, enrolled in the 401(k) Plan one dollar (\$1.00) per each hour worked for the Technical Engineers' Retirement Savings Fund (401(k) Plan). First, Second and Third Year Apprentices are not included in this Plan.

REGULAR SAVINGS PLAN:
 The employer shall deduct from the wages (after taxes) of each Technical Engineer and Instrument Man not enrolled in the 401(k) Plan one dollar and fifty cents (\$1.50) per each hour worked for the Technical Engineer's Savings Plan. The employer shall deduct from the wages (after taxes) of each Rodman, Fourth and Fifth Year Apprentices not enrolled in the 401(k) plan one dollar (\$1.00) per each hour worked for the Technical Engineer's Savings plan. First, Second and Third Year Apprentices are not included in this Plan.

WORKING DUES:
 The employer shall deduct (after taxes) thirty-two cents (\$0.32) per hour for each hour worked for each Technical Engineer, Party Chief, Licensed Land Surveyor and Instrument Man; and twenty-three cents (\$0.23) per each hour worked for each Rodman and Apprentice for Working Dues.

IMPORTANT NOTE	
TECHNICAL ENGINEERS' RETIREMENT SAVINGS FUND (401(K) PLAN) Effective June 1, 2007 a participant can direct more than the base contribution rate of \$1.50 per hour, in increments of (\$0.50) fifty cents, but not more than ten dollars (\$10.00) per hour to the 401(k) Plan.	
TECHNICAL ENGINEERS' SAVINGS PLAN Effective June 1, 2007 an employee has the following options:	
1)	An employee not participating in the 401(k) Plan can allocate more than \$1.50 per hour, in increments of fifty cents (\$0.50), to the Technical Engineers' Savings Plan.
2)	An employee in the 401(k) Plan can allocate at least \$1.50 per hour or more, in fifty cents (\$0.50) increments, to the Technical Engineers' Savings Plan, in addition to amounts contributed to the employee's 401(k) Plan.
