Dear Contractor:

Please be advised that under the terms of the third year of a three year Collective Bargaining Agreement between the Technical Engineering Division, Local Union 130 U.A., and the Builders Association of Greater Chicago, as represented by the Mid-America Regional Bargaining Agreement, we are supplying the wage and fringe benefit package effective June 1, 2009 through May 31, 2010.

The Prevailing wage in **Illinois** for Technical Engineers effective June 1, 2009 through May 31, 2010 are as follows:

The Technical Engineers Retirement Savings Fund 401 (k) and/or Regular Savings Plan Deduction of a minimum of \$1.50 per hour worked is for each Layout Technician, Licensed Land Surveyor, and Instrument Man and a \$1.00 per hour minimum for each hour worked for each Rodman and 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> Year Apprentices. 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Year Apprentices are not included in this plan. The working dues deduction (after taxes) of \$0.35 per hour worked is for Layout Technician, Licensed Land Surveyor, and Instrument Man and \$0.24 per hour for each hour worked for Rodman and Apprentices. 1<sup>st</sup> Year - 1<sup>st</sup> Six Months Apprentices are exempt from the working dues deductions.

**This, in effect, results in a total increase effective June 1, 2009 of two dollars and ninety cents (\$2.90) per hour.**
